

SOUND IT OUT!



LIPS THE FISH
Say the first few sounds. Read the end of the sentence and say it again.

LISTENING LION

Does the word make sense? If not, try again.

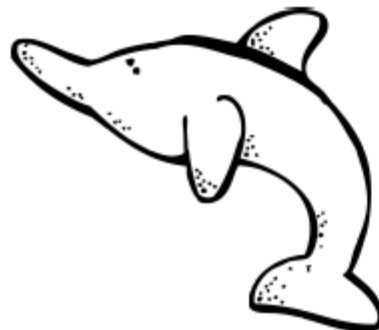


SKIPPY THE FROG
Stuck on the word? Skip it, read the rest of the sentence and hop back!



EAGLE EYES

Check the pictures for clues to help you.



FLIP THE DOLPHIN
Try the short vowel sound, then try the long vowel sound to sound it out.

CHUNKY MONKEY

Look for little words inside bigger words to help you sound it out.



STRETCHY SNAKE
Stretch the word out slowly. Say the sounds together to say the word.



As your child learns phonics patterns and becomes more and more familiar with the sounds letters make we often encourage them to use different strategies when they are faced with a word they have difficulty reading.
